

Mental Health Policy

Weybridge School of English (WISE) has a Student Welfare Officer (Liz Denham) who is available to support students in a professional and confidential manner with any problems that might arise whilst they are at the school and away from home.

At WISE, we are unable to accept students with significant mental health issues.

Students must inform us at enrolment, on the registration form, of any history of mental health problems so that we can advise them as to whether our courses are suitable for them.

If we become aware of serious issues after a student arrives, we can inform the student that we are not equipped to deal with such cases. In extreme cases, we can help the student make arrangements to leave the school and return home. The Student Welfare Officer can also involve the local mental health team if necessary. In this case, we make every effort not to cause distress to the student.
