With its Disability Policy, WISE aims to embed a culture of support and equal opportunities for students with disabilities or learning difficulties.

Please be aware that there is no wheelchair access at WISE'S main premises, 6 Baker Street, Weybridge.

WISE will ensure that:

- students and staff are given the opportunity to disclose a disability or learning difficulty when registering (students) or when completing WISE's application form (staff).
- the requirements of students or staff who disclose a disability or learning difficulty are assessed on an individual basis.
- reasonable adjustments are provided, within the resources available for students or staff who disclose a disability or learning difficulty. In excess of our available resources, adjustments may be offered and made for an additional fee, if possible.
- all discussions and information regarding a disability or learning difficulty are treated in a confidential manner.
